

Regulations of the Cropp Baltic Games Extreme Sports Festival 2018

§1

General provisions

The Funattack company Wojciech Tandeck is the organizer of the 10th edition of the festival in extreme sports, Baltic Games, which will take place at Plac Zebrań Ludowych on 17-19.08.2018. Term:

17/08/2018 - between the hours of 12-03

18/08/2018 - between the hours of 12-03

19/08/2018 - between the hours of 12-03

Place:

Gdańsk Oliwa Gate (former Plac Zebrań Ludowych).

§2

Organizer

The competition office will be located at the main entrance to the festival area

And it will be open from 17-19.08.2018 from 10:00 to 20:00

§3

Rules for participation

All persons participating in the event and staying at this facility are obliged to behave in a way that does not endanger the safety of other people and to comply with the following provisions of the regulations. The organizer of the event is entitled to record the course of the event, and in particular the behavior of people using video and sound recording devices

1) Prohibition of access to the facility (area) applies to:

- a) persons entered in the register of persons who have been banned from mass events,
- b) people who bring intoxicants, alcoholic beverages, psychotropic substances, weapons, pyrotechnic or explosive articles, possibly other dangerous objects or tools, as well as persons bringing items that make identification impossible, eg for balaclavas,
- c) people behaving aggressively, refusing to present a reliable document or checking luggage or clothing (if they suspect that they are trying to bring the aforementioned measures or objects),
- d) minors under 12 years of age, without the care of adult guardians,
- e) people who do not have a valid admission ticket

2) From the site - the people who are:

- a) behave aggressively, disturb the party or pose a threat to other people,
- b) despite the prohibition entered into or brought the above-mentioned forbidden measures or objects
- c) Persons present on the site are obliged to follow the ordering instructions of the organizer and the security services. In particular, the actions of security services are defined in a manual describing the tasks of the order service.
- d) In the case of resistance to the enforcement services mentioned above. persons will be immediately handed over to the Police.

- e) The activities mentioned above should be carried out in the least possible manner affecting human dignity and other personal rights of the person in relation to which they were taken.
- f) Minors are responsible for their guardians, or parents.
- g) Participants of the event acknowledge that admission to the event area is tantamount to the participation of the free photographing, filming or other recording of the person in connection with the event and the transmission, distribution or transmission of voice and image in connection with any program presenting the party.
- h) The organizer has the full right to use photo and video materials made at his event, to activities related to the promotion of the current and subsequent editions of the Baltic Games Festival in every possible form, regardless of the additional benefits obtained.
- i) Participants of the event acknowledge and agree that the noise level during stage performances may exceed the legally permissible conditions - Table No. 1 of the Ordinance of the Ministry of Health and Rural Development, dated. 15.05.1998 regarding the noise level in the environment (Journal of Laws No. 66, item 436).
- j) If a fire or other hazard is noticed, persons present on the site should:
- 1) immediately inform the Security Service,
 - 2) avoid panic,
 - 3) adhere to orders of Security Services and messages, follow the evacuation routes marked by roads,
 - 4) do not hinder access to emergency services.
- 5) A ban on the introduction of animals is strictly for the event area.
- 6) The car park of the organizer is located at the back of the stage.
- 7) Participants of the event acknowledge that the primary task of the security service is to counteract and prevent even the slightest threat to property and mass event participants. Any action taken by security services to prevent such phenomena is acceptable, provided that it is lawful.
- 8) Who does not carry out the order, issued on the basis of the Act by the Organizer or the Order Service, is liable to a fine of up to PLN 5,000 and may be deprived of the right to enter mass events for a period of 3 to 12 months. In relation to those who bring prohibited articles, their forfeiture will be adjudicated, even if they were not the property of the perpetrator.
- k) In the event of force majeure, the Organizer reserves the right to change the time or date and / or location of the event, and changes in this respect may not constitute grounds for additional obligations on the part of the organizers towards the participant

§4 Competition rules

Regulations of skateboarding and bmx competition at Cropp Baltic Games 2018

Every entered person can take part in the competition, which:

- finds in writing that their health allows their to take part in competitions,
- minors will submit their parents' permission to start their competition and their statement that their health allows them to take part in competitions,
- has a technically efficient bicycle and skateboard
- paid the starting fee
- will use a protective helmet during training and competition

- competitors who want to take part in the UCI and PZKol classifications must have cycling licenses

Applications take place up to 1 hour before the start of the elimination.

The qualifications will take place:

- bmx Friday 17/08/2018 at 15:00
- skateboard 18.08.2018 hours 14:00
- mtb 18/08/2018 hours 16:00

Six best players from the elimination and invited riders will be promoted to the semi-finals of skate and bmx. The MTB does not play out the semi-finals

In the semi-finals, 24 riders will take off.

- skateboard Saturday, 18/08/2018 at 17:00
- bmx Saturday 18/08/2018 at 19:00

In the finals 19.08.2018, there will be 12 skateboarders and bmx riders and 10 on DIRT MTB. Competitors resigning from participation in the competition during the competition, regardless of the reason for withdrawal, are obliged to immediately inform the competition office about this fact.

By completing the application form, the participant accepts the following arrangements:

- The organizer, all persons cooperating with organizer, as well as persons related to the organization and organization of the competition are not liable to the participants for personal, property and material damage that occurs before, during or after the competition.
- Participants start on their own responsibility.
- Contestants bear civil and legal liability for all damage caused by them. - By accepting this declaration, participants waive the right to seek legal or reprimand from the organizer or its contractors in the event of accident or injury related to the competition.
- In the event of an accident, the participant may not make any claims against the organizer.
- The participant acknowledges that the ordinances of order services and the regulations should be followed. - The participant agrees with the conditions of participation and declares his participation in the competition. - In the case of youth under 18, consent of a parent or legal guardian is required, by signing a statement on such consent.
- Photos, film recordings and interviews, as well as results with personal data can be used by the press, radio and television. - With his signature, the participant of the competition ensures that he has read all the terms and conditions of the competition and filled out the application form truthfully and completely. He also consents to the processing of his personal data in accordance with the Act of August 29, 1997. on the protection of personal data (Dz.U.Nr 133, item 883).

§5

Awards

Regulations for awarding awards at Baltic Games 2018

Cash prizes receive min. Top 3 competitors in 3 skateboard, mtb and bmx disciplines.

The organizer's responsibility is to calculate and pay to the relevant tax office the income tax due on the amount of cash prizes and the value of material prizes handed over to the prize-winning contestants under the terms of the Act of July 26, 1991. On income tax on natural persons (Journal of Laws No 14 from 200, item 176, as amended)

§ 6

Responsibility:

1. The organizer is not liable for damage caused by the sole fault of the aggrieved party or a third party for which he is not responsible.
2. For accidents that may happen during competition on skatepark obstacles located on the festival grounds, not due to negligence of the staff or the Organizer, the person using the obstacles for sport risk principle is solely responsible.
3. In the event of an injury or accident on the festival grounds, each victim is obliged to notify the staff of this fact immediately.
4. For damages caused to other participants in situations where their occurrence could not be prevented despite the personnel's due diligence, the perpetrator is responsible for the damage or the legal guardian's parents or legal guardians are liable.
5. The staff are not responsible for things left unattended on the festival grounds.

§ 7

Final Provisions:

1. By joining the Festival, the participant agrees to the terms of these regulations: for the processing of his personal data for the purpose of carrying out and implementation of the festival, and for publicly sharing his personal data and image in connection with the competition, in particular in the media by accepting the content of the statement required when making a notification.
2. The administrator of personal data of contest participants is Funattack Wojciech Tandeck. Personal data of Festival participants will be processed to the extent necessary for the organization of the Festival (in the scope and purposes related to the Festival, including its results) in accordance with the provisions on the protection of personal data, in particular the provisions of the Act on Personal Data Protection of 29 August 1997 (consolidated text Journal of Laws). The participant has the right to inspect data concerning him and the right to correct them.
3. Funattack reserves the right to change the regulations at any time. In this case, the information about the changes will be published in the same way as the original rules were announced.
4. In matters not regulated in these regulations, the relevant provisions of law shall apply, in particular the Civil Code and the Act on Copyright and Related Rights. 5. Regulations come into force on 15/06/2018.

ANNEX TO REGULATION No 1
INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

In connection with the start of application on 25 May 2018 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and the repeal of the Directive 95/46 / EC (general regulation on data protection) (hereinafter "the Regulation") we inform you that from May 25, 2018 you will be entitled to the rights set out below in relation to the processing of Wojciech Tandeck by Funattack; ul. Raciborski 93; 80-215 Gdańsk, your personal data.

At the same time, pursuant to art. 13 of the Regulation, we inform that:

1. The administrator of your personal data is the Funattack Company Wojciech Tandeck; ul. Raciborski 93; 80-215 Gdańsk; Tax ID: 957-053-63-11
2. Contact Funattack is possible via e-mail: kontakt@balticgames.co
3. Based on art. 6 sec. 1 lit. f) The Funattack Regulation processes your personal data for the following purposes:
 - (a) the inclusion of data in the participants' internal system;
 - b) preparing and issuing runbands;
 - c) preparing and printing start lists and placing lists on the website of the organized professions;
 - d) preparing, printing lists with the results of individual competitions and displaying a letter in the Competition Office and skatepark;
 - e) placing lists with the results of individual categories on the website of the organized professions, on the social networking site Facebook, and the Instagram application
 - f) place data on the lists of people for medal decorations;
 - g) posting data and providing letters to media partners and sponsors
 - k) in case of using accommodation organized via Funattack, placing data on hotel lists and providing lists of hotels, resorts, guesthouses with which Fanattack cooperates in order to organize.
4. The basis for the processing of your data is the legitimate interest pursued by Funattack through which the organization of the event resulting from the implementation of the Fanattack statutory objectives should be understood.
5. In connection with the processing of data for the purposes indicated in point 3 above, your personal data may be shared with other recipients or categories of recipients of personal data.
6. The recipients of your data may be:
 - a) Funattack employees and collaborators
 - b) external entities and their employees or co-workers, preparing and printing start lists;
 - c) external entities and their employees or co-workers, preparing and printing letters with the results of individual categories;
 - d) Fanattack volunteers;
 - e) companies and drivers of vehicles cooperating with Fanattack in the organization;
 - f) hotels, centers, pensions with which Fanattack cooperates in order to organize;
 - g) other participants of the organized professions;
 - h) persons within the organized professions;

i) users of the website, social networking site Facebook, instagram application

7. Your personal data will be processed for the period necessary for implementation indicated in point. 3 purposes, in relation to data processed for the purpose indicated in point 3 lit. a, until you object to the processing, in relation to the data provided for the purposes indicated in point. 3 lit. b-l until December 31, 2018

8. Your data will not be processed in an automated way as well as in the form of profiling.

9. In relation to the processing of your personal data by Fanaattack, you are entitled to:

a. the right to access the data content;

b. the right to rectify the data;

c. the right to delete data;

d. the right to limit data processing;

e. the right to object to the processing;

10. If you believe that Fanattack processing your personal data violates the provisions of the Regulation, you have the right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory body (ie until May 25, 2018 to the Inspector General for Personal Data Protection, and after that date to the appropriate successor body).

11. Providing your personal data by you is voluntary, but necessary to participate in organized competitions.

12. Fanattack will not transfer your personal data to a third country (outside the European Union or the European Economic Area) or to international organizations.
